Village Co-Living, a Helsinki based community living specialist and LiM, a Europe-wide specialist in affordable and sustainable housing, have joined forces to solve the problem of expensive and lonely living.

The project's target user group values affordable rent, everyday support from the community, high quality tailored spaces as well as the possibility to influence community decision making.

Development themes for the Re-thinking Urban Housing project:

- An apartment building tailored to the needs of co-living target user group (shared community living)
- Positive impact on neighborhood/region eg shared spaces, functionalities and services are opened to residents in the neighborhood/region
- Measurement of holistic sustainability
- Prefabricated modular construction combined with participatory community-based planning
- Applying international best practices and international peer learning
